

Gordon & Rees Continues to Climb National Law Journal's NLJ 500 and Women in Law Scorecard Rankings

Gordon Rees Scully Mansukhani has been ranked No. 24 on the *National Law Journal's* **Women in Law Scorecard**. This represents a 22 spot increase in the past five years. The Scorecard, produced as part of the NLJ 500 annual firm headcount report, ranks the largest law firms in the country by their representation of female attorneys within their firm.

In addition, among the top 25 firms, Gordon & Rees is No. 2 for the total number of U.S. female minority partners, and No. 8 for the percentage of U.S. partners who are minority women.

"We continue to make great strides, but recognize there is still work to be done and we will continue our vigorous efforts to support women, and those of diverse backgrounds, in all levels of firm leadership," said **Debra Ellwood Meppen**, Partner and Chair of the firm's Women's Initiative.

The firm was also recognized as No. 52 by global headcount on the **2021 NLJ 500** list. While the NLJ reported overall lawyer head count was down by 0.1 percent, Gordon & Rees showed 8.1 percent growth in headcount from the prior year.

In addition, the firm was recognized earlier this year by NLJ's sister publication *American Lawyer* as No. 92 on the AmLaw 100 rankings. The firm was among the top 15 firms with the greatest revenue increase over the past year.
