OVERVIEW

Commercial Litigation

- Represented a medical insurance carrier against breach of contract claims brought by a group of
 medical providers and quickly obtained an injunction protecting the personal and medical
 information of the insureds under HIPPA. Saved the client money by obtaining summary judgment
 early and therefore avoiding costly discovery.
- Represented an international electronics manufacturer in breach of contract and fraud litigation against a regional reseller who converted and disposed of equipment inventory without payment.
 Obtained a favorable default judgment that included treble damages.
