OVERVIEW

Rose's practice also includes representing clients in wage and hour actions arising under state and federal wage and hour laws. In addition to litigating on behalf of her clients, Rose provides client counseling on a variety of issues, including terminations and reductions, the interactive process under the ADA, Colorado's Healthy Families and Workplaces Act (HFWA), Family and



Medical Leave Insurance Program (FAMLI), and Protecting Opportunities and Workers' Rights (POWR) Act. This area of Rose's practice includes drafting compliant policies and handbooks.
